

VDV Addendum

IBEW Voice Data Video (VDV) Addendum to the National Maintenance Agreement (NMA) and the General Presidents Agreement on Project Maintenance (GPPMA)

The following scope of work may be performed by VDV employees under locally established VDV wage and fringe rates of pay (In areas where local VDV rates have not been established the rate of pay will be determined according to the IBEW/NECA Voice-Data-Video National Agreement) however all other terms and conditions will be subject to the NMA or GPPMA. On modified wage rate sites these employees will receive 100 % of their wages and fringes unless their wage and fringe package is higher than the modified rate of the inside journeyman wireman. In these cases they shall be paid the modified rate of the inside journeyman wireman.

This addendum was created at the request of valued owners who have agreed to use exclusively IBEW VDV contractors to perform their VDV work. Therefore use of this addendum may not be approved for employers performing work for owners who have not historically used IBEW contractors at their facilities or have not agreed to use IBEW contractors on future work.

SCOPE

The work covered by this addendum shall include the installation, testing, service, and maintenance of all VDV systems which utilize the transmission and/or transference of voice, sound, vision, or digital for commercial, education, security, and entertainment purposes for the following: TV monitoring and surveillance, background/foreground music, intercom and telephone interconnect, inventory control systems, microwave transmission, multimedia, multiplex, nurse call systems, radio page, school intercom and sound, burglar alarms, and low-voltage master clock systems.

 1. Background/foreground music
 2. Intercom and telephone interconnect systems
 3. Telephone systems
 4. Nurse call systems
 5. Radio page systems
 6. School intercom and sound systems
 7. Burglar alarm systems
 8. Low-voltage master clock systems
 9. Multimedia/multiplex systems
 10. Sound and musical entertainment systems
 11. RF systems
 12. Antennas and wave guide


D. COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS THAT TRANSMIT OR RECEIVE INFORMATION AND/OR CONTROL SYSTEMS THAT ARE INTRINSIC TO THE ABOVE-LISTED SYSTEMS (IN THE "SCOPE")

1. SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition)
2. PCM (Pulse Code Modulation)
3. Inventory control systems
4. Digital data systems
5. Broadband and baseband and carriers
6. Point-of-sale systems
7. VSAT data systems
8. Data communication systems
9. RF and remote-control systems
10. Fiber-optic data systems

E. VDV SUPPORT SYSTEMS SUCH AS DATA-TRACK, INNERDUCT, OR SIMILAR-TYPE RACEWAYS AND LADDER RACK INTENDED SPECIFICALLY FOR THE ABOVE-LISTED SYSTEMS. *(If these support systems also carry low voltage control circuits covered under Article 2 Section B below, they shall be installed by inside wiremen.)*

2. This addendum specifically excludes the following work:
 - A. Raceway systems are not covered under the terms of this addendum except for those listed in Item 1 E., above. Chases, sleeves, and/or nipples (not to exceed 10 feet) may be installed on open wiring systems. (*Raceway systems include but are not limited to, cable tray, EMT, IMC, rigid conduit, pvc, and wiremold.*)
 - B. The complete installation of energy management systems, computer systems in industrial applications such as process controls, assembly lines, robotics, and computer-controlled manufacturing systems, and all HVAC control work shall not be a part of this addendum. (*This is interpreted to mean any system that controls lighting, HVAC or power regardless of voltage or type of cable used would not be covered under the scope of this addendum.*)
 - C. Life safety systems [not intrinsic to nurse call systems listed in Article 1 Section A above] shall be excluded from this addendum.
 - D. SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) where not intrinsic to the above-listed systems (in the "Scope").
3. Nothing contained in this "Scope" or any other section of this addendum shall prevent a contractor who is signatory to a NMA Extension Request or the GPPMA from performing VDV work with inside journeyman wiremen using the inside rate of pay.
4. Any disputes or questions regarding the above scope shall be resolved and or interpreted solely by the International President or his designee. Failure of an employer to comply with the International President's decision will be subject to the respective grievance procedure.
5. This addendum may be altered or canceled by the International President upon a thirty day written notice to the NMAPC and the GPC.
